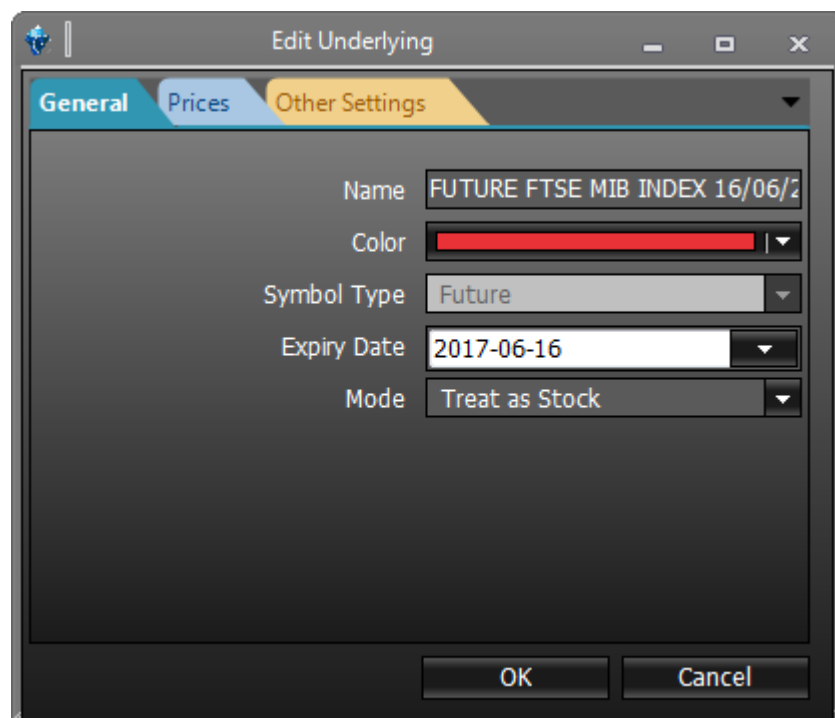


## Edit Underlying / Edit Option
